

Undergraduate Grants, Scholarships and Awards

Restricted Grants, Scholarships, Loans and Awards

There are no special application forms for restricted and endowed scholarships. Recipients are selected by deans or department chairpersons based on criteria established by the donors. These awards are generally made for one year only and are based on the availability of funds in any given year. The following are awarded on the basis of academic achievement and/or financial need.

School of Architecture

George D. Bartlett Grant/Architecture

A fund established in memory of George D. Bartlett, former teacher of mathematics and English.

Brian Boxall Memorial Scholarship/Architecture

Awarded to an architecture student from a fund established by friends and relatives of Brian Boxall, who died during his fourth year of study in architecture.

Patrick Corvo Memorial Scholarship/Architecture

A scholarship established by the family and friends of Patrick Corvo ('88) following his tragic death. An award to a student entering the final year of study in the School of Architecture who has demonstrated a serious commitment to the field of architecture and who has financial need.

Ruben Delgado Memorial Scholarship for Hispanic Students/Architecture

A scholarship fund established from the estate of Ruben Delgado for financially needy Hispanic students in the School of Architecture.

C. Franklin Edminster Scholarship/Architecture

A fund established by alumni and friends in memory of C. Franklin Edminster, former chairman of the Department of Architecture.

William and Idella Elder Foundation/Architecture and Art and Design

A fund for scholarship aid to junior-andSenior-Level Students in Art and Design and Architecture.

Louis W. Feldmann Scholarship/Architecture

A bequest by Louis W. Feldmann, a Pratt graduate (Architecture), in memory of his wife and son, awarded annually to a worthy student.

Benjamin Goldberger Memorial Scholarship/Architecture A scholarship established by Beatrice Goldberger ('34) in honor of her father, Benjamin Goldberger ('08).

Jack and Florence Goodstein Memorial Scholarship/Architecture

An award by Steven Goodstein in memory of his parents, given to deserving Construction Management students.

William Randolph Hearst Scholarship for Opportunity/ Architecture

A fund established by the William Randolph Hearst Foundation for minority students in Architecture.

Sidney Katz Memorial Scholarship Fund/Architecture

A fund established in memory of Sidney Katz that is intended to extend opportunities to talented graduate students of Architecture.

Amy C. Koe Endowed Scholarship Fund/Architecture

An endowed scholarship established by Amy C. Koe in memory of William Koe, an alumnus, for needy and deserving students in Architecture.

Alvan C. Nye Grant/Architecture

A fund in memory of Alvan C. Nye, former instructor of Architectural Design.

Henry L. Parkhurst Grant/Architecture

A fund established by students, alumni, and friends in memory of Henry L. Parkhurst, a former instructor of interior Architectural Design.

J. Gerald Phelan Award/Architecture

An award established in the name of J. Gerald Phelan, alumnus of the School of Architecture, granted annually to an outstanding architecture student interested in serving the needs of the profession and community.

Planning Scholarship/Architecture

A scholarship fund established for students studying in the graduate program in City and Regional Planning.

Pratt Institute Construction Management Alumni Association Scholarship/Architecture

A fund established for students in Construction Management.

Pratt Planning Alumni Scholarship/Architecture

A fund established by Pratt Planning Alumni for students in the graduate Planning Program in the School of Architecture.

Pratt Senior Intern Award and Program/Art and Design and Architecture

Fifteen students who perform an internship during their junior year receive awards in their senior year and participate in a year-long field seminar on post-graduate career development. Awarded annually on the basis of scholarship and need.

Frank O. Price Scholarship/Architecture

A fund established by friends of Professor Price, longtime teacher in Architecture, awarded to a worthy student.

Edward D. Re, Jr. Scholarship/Architecture

A fund in honor of Edward D. Re Jr., a Pratt alumnus, for students studying Construction Management.

Bernard W. Reed Memorial Fund/Architecture

For aid to students in Construction Management with gifts received from faculty and friends in memory of Bernard W. Reed, former dean of the School of Continuing Professional Studies.

Clyde Lincoln Rounseville Scholarship Fund/Architecture

Awarded to deserving students in the School of Architecture.

Edward Rudin Memorial Building Science Scholarship Fund/Architecture

A fund to assist deserving students in Construction Management.

Francis Seaman Memorial Scholarship/Architecture

A fund established in memory of Francis Seaman, former president of the Switzer Foundation and a graduate of the School of Architecture. To be awarded on the basis of demonstrated need and academic performance to female students who have completed at least the first year in the School of Architecture and who live within a fifty-mile radius of New York City.

Herbert Lewis Smith Scholarship/Architecture

A bequest from the estate of Herbert Lewis Smith, to be awarded to students in the School of Architecture.

Vincent A. Stabile Endowed Scholarship/Architecture

A scholarship fund established by Vincent A. Stabile for students in the School of Architecture.

Gihei and Sato Takeuchi Memorial Endowed Scholarship Fund/Architecture

A fund established by Pratt graduate John M. Takeuchi (Arch. '47) in memory of his parents, Gihei and Sato Takeuchi, for a second year, full-time, matriculated architecture student who shows promise through academic achievement.

Lucinda Veikos Endowed Scholarship/Architecture

A fund established by William and Elizabeth Pederson in memory of Lucinda Veikos for a deserving student in the School of Architecture.

Veikos Travel Scholarship for Architectural Study and Travel/Architecture

A scholarship established by Kohn Pederson Fox Associates in honor of Lucinda Veikos for travel abroad for a deserving student in the School of Architecture.

Benjamin C. Warner Grant/Architecture

A fund established by Mrs. Margaret Jones, mother of former architecture student Warner Jones, in memory of her grandfather, Benjamin C. Warner.

Arthur Williams Trust Scholarship/Architecture

An award to be used for the education and/or maintenance, in whole or in part, of one or more needy and deserving students in architecture.

A scholarship established by Ralph Appelbaum for needy and deserving students in Industrial Design.

Toyce Anderson Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

A memorial scholarship established in memory of Toyce Anderson, artist, costume designer, and former student, for undergraduate students in interdisciplinary studies in Art and Design.

Art Alumni Association Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established by the Art Alumni Association, awarded to a deserving student.

Art Students' Association Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund raised by the Art Students' Association over a period of years, awarded by competition.

Mary Pratt Barringer Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

Scholarships of \$2,500 each to deserving undergraduate students from Delaware College of Art and Design to be selected by a joint committee of representatives from both schools.

Charles Bennett Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established by Charles Bennett to be used for the benefit of male students in any fine arts courses.

Bernice Bienenstock Furniture Library Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship awarded to students pursuing home furnishings-related studies.

Ruth Campbell Bigelow and David E. Bigelow Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

Awarded to a student in Interior Design on the basis of need and academic promise.

Francis E. Blod Memorial Fellowship/Art and Design

Awarded for the purpose of furthering the professions of packaging and communications design. Funded in part by the Package Designers Council.

Raymond and Mabel Bolton Art and Design Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship fund established in honor of Raymond and Mabel Bolton for deserving students in the School of Art and Design.

Alma H. Borgfeldt Scholarship/Art and Design

A bequest by Alma H. Borgfeldt for scholarships for worthy female students to be selected by the dean of the School of Art and Design. The scholarships are awarded to applicants who have majored in the study of art in a public high school located in Kings County (Brooklyn) and who reside in Kings County (Brooklyn).

Anita J. Brady Grant/Art and Design

A fund established by alumni, faculty, and friends in memory of Anita J. Brady, a former teacher in the Department of Physical Education, awarded in alternate years to students who have completed one term of work at the Institute.

Mary Buckley Scholarship/ Art and Design

A scholarship awarded to Foundation students for excellence in color work.

Robert F. Calrow Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship fund established by Trudi Calrow in memory of her husband, Robert F. Calrow, a well-known painter and inspirational teacher. A scholarship will be awarded annually to a Fine Arts major on the basis of merit and need.

Federico Castellon Endowed Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship established by Hilda Castellon in memory of her husband, Federico Castellon, to be awarded on a yearly basis to a promising student in Graphic Arts.

Albert Christ-Janer Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

Scholarships awarded in memory of the former art school dean.

Coyne Family Foundation Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A fund established from the Richard and Jean Coyne Family Foundation for students in Communication Design.

Creative Process Fund Award/Art and Design

A fund established by the Creative Process Fund, Inc. An award of \$500 will be presented annually to a junior year student who has exhibited outstanding achievement in the area of Graphic Design.

Marion Bowen Davis Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established in honor of Marion Bowen Davis for female students who are juniors or seniors in the School of Art and Design majoring in Pictorial Illustration, Fashion Design, or Painting and who are citizens of the United States.

Katherine E. Deforest Grant/ Art and Design

A bequest by Katherine E. DeForest and Ida Teed, graduates of the teacher training course, awarded to a student in Art Education or the Fine Arts.

Charles Duncan Award/Art and Design

A matching grant from the Avon Foundation to provide financial support for students in the School of Art and Design.

Gertrude C. Duntz Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund in honor of Gertrude C. Duntz, former faculty member, awarded to a student in Fashion Design.

William and Idella Elder Foundation/Art and Design and Architecture

A fund for scholarship aid to junior-and senior-level students in Art and Design and Architecture.

Faith Ellis Art Financial Aid Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established by Faith Ellis ('39) in memory of her son Roland R. Ellis to enable students to access special training as determined by the Art Education Department.

Sarah Fawcett Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

In memory of Sarah Fawcett, supervisor of drawing in Newark, New Jersey, awarded biennially by the Newark superintendent of schools.

William Fogler Endowed Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A scholarship established in memory of Professor William A. Fogler for promising

students in Industrial Design.

Ford Design Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established by the Ford Motor Company to encourage women and minorities to study Automotive Design.

Abraham Frankfurt Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship established in honor of Abraham Frankfurt for students in Art and Design.

Jacques and Natasha Gelman Endowed Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship established by the Jacques and Natasha Gelman Trust for undergraduate students in the studio arts. Preference is to be given to students of Mexican descent or, if none are available, to students of Latino descent.

Jacques and Natasha Gelman Travel and Study Grant/Art and Design

A grant awarded to a student of exceptional talent in the field of painting or drawing, as selected by a designated art faculty panel.

General Motors Corporation Scholarship/Art and Design

Several partial-tuition scholarships awarded to students in Industrial Design.

Francesco Gianninoto Scholarship/Art and Design

Annual scholarship by the Package Design Council International to a graduate student in Communications/Package Design who has a proven record of merit, competence, academic excellence, financial need, and dedication to package design as a career goal.

Vincent Giuliani Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

Established by the family of the late artist/alumnus ('51) to be used yearly for aid to students.

Mitchell P. Gould Memorial Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A scholarship fund in memory of Mitchell P. Gould, the income of which will be applied annually toward the tuition and fees of students in the Departments of Industrial and Interior Design, with an interest to work in the field of furniture design, and who merit financial assistance.

Richard E. And Anne L. Boetzel Gunn Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A scholarship to be awarded annually, beginning in the year 2000, to a student majoring in Communications Design on the basis of scholarly achievement, with preference given to students majoring in Advertising Design or Illustration.

Estelle and Moses Gutzbezahl Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established in honor of Estelle and Moses Gutzbezahl for a student in Industrial Design.

Howard Hardy Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship established in honor of artist Howard Hardy, a former instructor, for a senior in Fine Arts.

Ida C. Haskell Foreign Traveling Scholarship/Art and Design

A bequest by Ida C. Haskell, awarded to a senior for travel abroad within two years from

the date of graduation.

Barbara Hauben Ross Award Fund/Art and Design

A fund established by David Bellin in honor of his wife, Barbara Hauben Ross, interior designer and graduate of Pratt Institute ('61). Annual awards to be made to two outstanding juniors in the Department of Interior Design.

Helen of Klucharka Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship in memory of Helen Markowitz-Katz Davis. Awarded annually to students in Fashion Design.

Rowena Reed Kostellow Fund/Art and Design

A fund established in honor of Rowena Reed Kostellow, former instructor and chairperson of the Industrial Design Department, which she and her husband, Alexander Kostellow, founded in 1939. One of the programs is the Student Award for Excellence, which will be given to the leading Industrial Design student as selected by protocols established by the trustees and faculty of the Industrial Design Department.

Matthew J. Hennessey Communications Design Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A fund established by Sudler and Hennessey, Inc., in honor of their founder, Matthew J. Hennessey, who attended Pratt Institute. One award given each year to a sophomore in Communications Design who has an interest in pursuing a career in the field of advertising design.

John S. Hilson Family Fund/Art and Design

A fund established by the Hilson family to enhance and strengthen the graduate Communications Design program. Part of the fund will be used for scholarships for students in graduate Communications Design.

Steve Horn Art and Design Award/Art and Design

A fund established by Linda Horn in honor of alumnus Steve Horn. An annual award to a student who has demonstrated excellence and outstanding performance in Photography, Film, or other Media Arts.

Mary B. Hyde Grant/Art and Design

A fund established by an anonymous donor in honor of Mary B. Hyde, supervisor emerita of art teacher education, awarded to a student in Art Education.

Industrial Design Scholarship/Art and Design

For a number of scholarships from a fund established by business contributions, awarded to students in Industrial Design for experimental projects in the laboratory.

Harley M. Jones Endowed Scholarship/Art and Design

An endowed scholarship established from the estate of Harley M. Jones, architect and professor, to provide yearly scholarships to African American students in good academic standing enrolled in the Interior Design Department.

Harley Morton Jones Memorial Award/Art and Design

A scholarship established in memory of Harley Morton Jones, architect and professor. The award will be given to an undergraduate Interior Design student whose thesis best illustrates interior design's role in furthering humanitarian concerns.

Melvin K. Jung Memorial Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

Awarded to a worthy graduate student in Industrial Design.

Bob Keane Memorial Endowed Scholarship/Art and Design

Bob Keane (1950–1991) was a gifted nature photographer, much of whose work was done in the New York parks that were a legacy of Olmstead and Vaux. He had several exhibitions in Paris and New York before his career was cut short by AIDS. This scholarship is offered from an endowment created by his partner, Robert Weingarten. An award is made annually by the Office of Financial Aid to a gay or lesbian Pratt student who shows exceptional promise as a photographer and has demonstrated financial need.

Ezra J. Keats Scholarship and Internship/Art and Design

Funds awarded for both scholarships to children enrolled in the Saturday Art Education Program and a scholarship/internship for a student majoring in Graphic Arts.

Kodak Professional Imaging Scholarship/Art and Design

A one-year scholarship of \$1,000 awarded to a Photography major by Professional Imaging of Eastman Kodak.

William and Amy C. Koe Scholarship/Art and Design

A partial scholarship for a student with creative ability in the field of Fine Arts to be used for travel or study outside of the continental United States.

Alexander J. Kostellow Fellowship/Art and Design

A fund established by students and friends of the late chairman of the Foundation and Industrial Design departments, awarded to a graduate student in Industrial Design.

Herschel Levit Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship established in memory of Herschel Levit, a faculty member in the School of Art and Design, for a sophomore or junior.

Ted and Betsy Lewin Endowed Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A scholarship established by Ted and Betsy Lewin for needy and deserving students in Illustration.

William L. Longyear Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established by students, alumni, and friends from the business world as a tribute to William L. Longyear, associate dean emeritus and former chairman of the Department of Advertising Design, awarded annually to Communications Design students and to graduate Packaging Design students on the basis of need and scholarship. The recipients are nominated by the department chairpersons and two faculty members for approval by the dean of the School of Art and Design.

Isabel Ely Lord Award/Art and Design

An award of fine books for a fashion art or design senior who consistently demonstrates high standards in English and composition, from a fund established by the normal household arts class of 1915 in memory of Miss Lord's service as director.

Lorenzetti Prize/Art and Design

An annual award to be used for travel to Italy by a graduating senior who is majoring in Fine Arts. The recipient will be selected by a committee of Fine Arts faculty.

Jeffrey Lundstedt Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

An award for an outstanding student in Graphics from a fund established by family, faculty, and friends in memory of Jeffrey Lundstedt.

Mary Martin Scholarship/Art and Design

Bequest by Mary Martin, Pratt alumna, awarded to a Fashion student who has completed his or her freshman year.

Claude H. Muller Grant/Art and Design

A bequest by Mrs. Henry Muller in memory of her son, Claude H. Muller.

Grace B. Munroe Grant/Art and Design

A bequest in memory of Grace Bigelow Munroe, a former Pratt student, awarded to a student in Art Education, Industrial Design, Environmental Design, or the Fine Arts.

New York Times Education Fellowship/Art and Design

A grant established by the New York Times Foundation to fund fellowships for graduate education majors to teach observational drawing at Beginning with Children, a public school in Williamsburg, Brooklyn.

Ransom E. Noble (Jr.) Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund initiated by the Pratt Institute Alumni Association of Fashion and Foods, friends, and associates as a tribute for his many years of service as a faculty member and dean, awarded annually to an outstanding senior in the Fashion curriculum, based on student's need, merit, and leadership.

Burrel L. and Frances Craver Northam Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established from the Burrel L. and Frances Craver Northam Scholarship Foundation for incoming students in the School of Art and Design.

Package Designers Council Scholarship/Art and Design

Two \$500 fellowships to graduate packaging students who exhibit ability, scholarship, and financial need.

Glenn E. Pangborn Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established for worthy and needy students.

Walter Scott Perry Service Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established by the Art Alumni Association in honor of Walter Scott Perry, former director of the School of Art and Design, awarded by competition to a senior.

Point of Purchase Scholarship/Art and Design

The Point of Purchase Scholarship is funded by grants from numerous companies with significant interest in the design of displays used at the point of purchase (POP). An annual award to either undergraduate or graduate Industrial Design students who have demonstrated design leadership potential in the field of POP design.

Elaine Gluckman Popowitz Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

Awarded to a returning student whose dedication to his or her studies and personal qualities reflect those of Elaine Gluckman Popowitz. Preference is given to students of Art Therapy.

Lillian Pratt Fashion Scholarship/Art and Design

Awarded to an outstanding student in fashion design in his or her junior and senior year.

Pratt Senior Intern Award and Program/Art and Design and Architecture

Fifteen students who perform an internship during their junior year receive \$2,500 awards in their senior year and participate in a yearlong field seminar on postgraduate career development. Awarded annually on the basis of scholarship and need.

Printmaking Department Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship fund established for students majoring in printmaking.

George Anton Redling Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established in memory of George Anton Redling, an alumnus, for a deserving art student.

Walter Rogalski Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A scholarship awarded annually to a graduate Fine Arts student on the basis of merit and need, as selected by a faculty committee that reviews candidates who exemplify the creative ability that characterized Walter Rogalski's work.

Marc Rosen Scholarship

Funded by friends and associates of Marc Rosen in his honor, this award is made to an outstanding graduate Communications/ Package Design student. The winner is selected by the chairperson and members of the faculty of the graduate Communications/Packaging Departments.

Alvin Ross Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship established in memory of Alvin Ross, professor and chairman of the History of Art Department.

Anna W. Rust Endowed Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship for students in the School of Art and Design established by Leo Lewis Rust in memory of his wife, Anna Klenke Rust, a former Pratt Institute student.

George Sakier Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship awarded to graduate students in Industrial Design.

Alexander Sarkis, Jr. Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

A memorial scholarship established in memory of Alexander Sarkis, Jr. (ID '58) for undergraduate students in Industrial Design.

Sassetta Award/Art and Design

An annual award for a Pratt student to attend the Pratt Tuscany Summer Program.

Dorothy G. Schmidt Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

A scholarship established in honor of Dorothy G. Schmidt, to be used for elementary and junior high school teachers seeking courses at Pratt for professional enhancement in their work teaching art and related subjects in the public schools of Brooklyn, on the basis of need. Other factors being equal, females shall be given preference.

Frederick J. Schuback Endowed Scholarship/Fine Arts

To be awarded to one fine art undergraduate each year who is in good academic standing and who demonstrates financial need-FAFSA form must be filed.

Catherine D. Seemann and Mabel McGurn Burse Fund/Art and Design

A fund established by Harriet McCartin in memory of her mother, Pratt alumna Catherine Seemann, and aunt, Mabel M. Burse, awarded to students in the Fashion Design and the Merchandising and Fashion Management programs.

James Seeman Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship created by family and friends of James Seeman, a leader in the interior design profession and a gifted muralist. Awarded annually to a dedicated painting student with financial need. Preference is given to students who recently moved to the United States.

Katherine E. Shattuck Grant/Art and Design

A fund established by teacher training graduates in memory of Katherine E. Shattuck, supervisor of the teacher training course for twenty years, awarded to a student in Art Education.

David B. Smith, Traveling Scholarship/Art and Design

This gift in honor of David B. Smith, Art and Design ('56), is to be used to assist an Industrial Design student in travel between the junior and senior years in order to learn more about the industrial design profession.

Society of Illustrators Hallmark Fund Grant/Art and Design

Annual scholarship competition conducted by the Society of Illustrators for students in college-level art schools and universities.

Starr Foundation Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship fund established by the Starr Foundation for Asian students in the Department of Communications Design. Awards will be made annually to three students majoring in Illustration, Graphic Design, and Advertising.

Laura A. Steel Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established in recognition of Laura A. Steel, head worker at the Greenpoint Neighborhood House, awarded to a Fashion Design student who has completed the freshman year.

Sudler and Hennessey Scholarship/Art and Design

A scholarship awarded by Sudler and Hennessey, Inc., to be awarded to a student in Communications Design.

Switzer Foundation Scholarship/Art and Design

In memory of Margaret and Sarah Switzer, to be distributed annually among female students who are majoring in Fashion Design and who live within a fifty-mile radius of New York City.

Taki-Fuji Award/Traveling Scholarship/Art and Design

Awarded to an Industrial Design student in the junior year. Every even-numbered year, the student winner travels to Japan to receive the award personally from Mr. Hisao Taki, founder of the award in honor of his father.

Ruth P. Taylor Scholarship/Art and Design

A fund established by the estate of Ruth P. Taylor for students in the School of Art and Design.

Taylor & Ives Scholarship Award for Design Excellence/Art and Design

Awarded by Taylor & Ives Incorporated to a graduate Communications Design or

Packaging Design student with a proven record of merit, competence, academic excellence, and financial need, who has completed a minimum of two semesters of work.

Christina M. Thompson Scholarship Fund/Art and Design

The income from a bequest to be awarded to a worthy student who has completed the first year, preferably in Fashion Design.

Peter von der Geest Memorial Scholarship/Art and Design

A memorial scholarship established in memory of Peter Von Der Geest (Int. Des., '59) for undergraduate students in Interior Design.

Mabel Sanger Webb Fund/Art and Design

Bequest from the estate of Miss Mabel Sanger Webb, class of 1916 in normal art. Miss Webb taught for nine years in the Department of Fine Arts and the Department of Household Arts. Income to be used annually for scholarship assistance to students in the M.S. (Art Education) and M.F.A. programs.

Max Weber Scholarship Fund/Art and Design
