1. Online grade submittal is optional for Fall 2007.
2. Late or missing grades are automatically recorded as "NG" (No Grade). NG-designated grades could prevent a student from graduating or continuing their education.
3. Grades submitted online will be available for viewing online as soon as they are entered; grades submitted in paper will be available online within 24 hours of being turned in to the Registrar's Office.
