Terms of the Meal Plan Contract

2011-2012

For the consideration exchanged herein, Pratt Institute (Institute) and Enrolled Pratt Student (Student) or Faculty/Staff Member enter into covenant and agree as follows:

Choice Of Plans: A Student or Faculty/Staff member may choose from the Yearly Plans or the Semester Plans offered through the Institute. Mealplan points may be used in the Main Dining Hall, the Pizza Shop, the Higgins Hall coffee shop and the Convenience Store in Willoughby Hall.

Term Of This Contract: The Yearly Meal Plan Contract (Contract) is for one academic year (both the Fall and Spring Semesters) in the 2011-2012 Academic Year. The Semester Plan Contract (Contract) is for one semester (either Fall or Spring semester) in the 2011-2012 Academic Year. Dining service provided under this contract shall fall between the *first day of New International Student check-in* and *the day on which Non-Graduating Students check-out* (please refer to dates published in the annual Residence Hall Housing License for specific dates). The Institute shall provide a Board Plan (also identified as Meal Plan or Plan) and the Student agrees to pay the stated amount and abide by the further terms of this Contract. Resident students assigned to Cannoneer Court, Leo J. Pantas Hall, Esther Lloyd-Jones Hall, or Stabile Hall are required to participate in either the M3 or M4 of the Yearly Plans. (Neither Cannoneer, Pantas, ELJ, nor Stabile Hall has kitchen facilities so enrollment in this plan is mandatory for those who live there.) In addition, all first-year freshmen students living on campus are required to participate in either M3 or M4 of the Yearly Plans, regardless of hall assignment. Please refer to Board Plan Meal Schedule section below for information concerning specific dates of operation covered during the term of this contract.

Cost: The cost for the chosen Plan as indicated on the front is billed to the Student's account. The Yearly Meal Plan will be billed to the student's account for the Fall semester and automatically again for the Spring semester. For new enrollments starting in the Spring semester, the cost of the Yearly Meal Plan will be billed only for the Spring Semester. The cost of the Semester Plan will be billed to the student's account only for the semester for which the student signs up (either Fall or Spring).

Meal Plan Points: Students who purchase one of these Meal Plans shall be granted a specified number of Meal Plan Points (Points) according to the Plan selected. For the Yearly Plans, points are credited to the student meal plan account at the rate of 50% of total plan points at the beginning of each semester. For the Semester Plans, points are credited to the student meal plan account at the rate of 100% of total plan points at the beginning of the semester for which the plan is assigned. Points allocated to the student's Plan are then reduced by 1 point for every dollar in food purchased.

Additional Meal Plan Points: Additional Meal Plan Points may be purchased online through the prattcard.com system. When additional Points are purchased, those Points become subject to the specified contractual regulations in accordance with the Plan to which they are added.

Unused Points: At the end of any given semester, there might be unused Points remaining from a Student's Plan. Unused Points for the Yearly Plans carry over from the fall semester to the spring semester within any given Academic Year provided the student is still on the same plan. Unused points for the Semester Plans *do not carry over* from the fall to the spring. In any Plan, points do not carry over from one academic year to the next. Points remaining at the end of the spring semester are automatically forfeited by the Student. If the student cancels the Contract, he/she will not be entitled to carry over unused Points.

Cancellations & Refund Schedule: To cancel this Contract for either Plan specified, the Student must submit a Housing/Dining Services Adjustment form indicating cancellation to the Office of Residential Life. Students required to participate in the Mandatory Plan based on their housing assignment may cancel their Board Plan Contract only if moving off-campus or to a room with a kitchen. All first-year freshmen students living on campus are required to participate in one of the Mandatory Meal Plans for both Fall and Spring semesters, regardless of hall assignment.

The following refund schedule applies to either Plan. Cancellations *after the first day of New Domestic Student check in for either semester* will be assessed \$250 penalty plus any points used. "Points used" equals the number of points used as of the date a student's enrollment in the Plan is canceled. Students who have canceled either Plan will not be entitled to use remaining Points.

Board Plan Meal Schedule: The regular Board Plans' meal schedule for Monday through Friday is breakfast, lunch and dinner. On Saturdays, Sundays and Institute holidays, the dining service Board Plan meals will be provided for brunch and dinner only. The Institute will provide limited dining service or no use of plan points under any Board Plan during the official vacation and close-down periods. This includes but is not limited to Winter Break and Spring Break, during which there is no weekend service.

Identification Cards / Charges: The Institute shall provide the student with a mag-stripe affixed to the Pratt student ID card. The Student must present the card at the dining hall to be served. This card is non-transferable and non-assignable. The student understands that this card may not be used by anyone else for dining service entitlement. Alteration or use of this card for any unauthorized purpose may result in additional charges, Institute disciplinary action and/or confiscation of the card.

Lost cards must be replaced by notifying the Office of Campus Security AND the Office of Dining Services *immediately* and indicating the need for a replacement card. Students will be charged for replacement of lost cards.

Responsibility: The Institute shall not be responsible or liable for delay, curtailment and/or non-delivery of meal service, or any other non-performance hereunder, directly or indirectly resulting from and/or contributed to by acts of God, the adoption of any law, ordinance, regulation, ruling, or order, lack of usual means of transportation, fires, floods, explosions, strikes, or other accidents or contingencies beyond the Institute's control.

The Institute may revoke and terminate this contract (i) if the Student fails to be or to continue to be throughout the term of this contract, a registered student at the Institute or to complete settlement of his/her Institute financial account in accordance with established policies and procedures; (ii) if the student fails for any reason to comply with the provisions of this Contract or with any policy, procedure, rule or regulation adopted by the Institute in the interests of health, safety, and proper conduct of students and the orderly and efficient operation and administration of the Board Program.

"Registered" shall mean that the Institute Registrar's Office has a record that the student has registered, in accordance with Institute policies and procedures, as a student at the Institute for the current and all past academic semesters falling partially or wholly within the term of this contract. "Settlement" shall mean that the Institute Bursar's Office has a record that the student has settled his/her account in accordance with Institute policies and procedures for the current and all past academic semesters falling partially or wholly within the term of this contract.

In the event the Institute terminates this Contract or enrollment at Pratt Institute no refund or credit is due the Student under the terms of this Contract.

Assignment / Modification: This Contract may not be assigned by the Student. The Institute reserves the right to make reasonable modifications or amendments to this Contract and such shall be effective upon notice to the Student.

Governing Law: This Contract is governed by the laws of the State of New York and is subject to the jurisdiction of the New York State Courts. When enrolling under this plan, it shall be understood that in the event the services of a collection agency and/or an attorney are required in order to collect the unpaid balance the Student shall be responsible for payment of collection costs and/or actual costs of legal services. In addition, the Institute may disclose the information to credit bureau organizations.
