About the Pratt Center for Community Development

Established in 1963, the Pratt Center for Community Development works for a more sustainable and equitable New York City in partnership with community-based organizations, small businesses, and policymakers. As part of Pratt Institute, we work to advance urban planning and public policies that support community-based organizations in their efforts to improve quality of life, create economic opportunity, and advance sustainable development. Our work is grounded in four core values: Equity, Sustainability, Local Knowledge, and Diverse Economy.

Fellowship information

One fellowship opportunity is available at the Pratt Center for Community Development for a MS Data Analytics and Visualization student. The 2023-2024 fellow will work on a variety of projects to support affordable housing, climate justice, and equitable economic development in NYC. Projects can include geospatially projecting data, such as producing city-wide maps of different types of building and housing stock, various legislative boundaries, and other types of data in support of affordable housing policy campaigns.

The fellowship recipient will commit to a hybrid work environment (in-person and online) at the Pratt Center for 8 hours/week (120 hours/semester for the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters; 30 weeks total from September 2023-May 2024). This fellowship includes a scholarship in the amount of \$7,450 that will be divided equally between the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters. The fellow must be currently enrolled in the MS in Data Analytics and Visualization program. In spring 2024, the fellow may take either Practicum/Seminar <u>or</u> present their fellowship project at #infoshow2024 at the end of the semester. The successful applicant must take at least 6 credits in both the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters.

Please note that continuing the fellowship through spring 2024 is contingent upon review of the fall 2023 semester by Pratt Center staff. The fellowship recipient will be selected by Pratt Center staff following an initial review by Pratt-SI staff. Official notification will be made in late April 2023.

<u>Eligibility</u>

To be eligible for consideration, an applicant must have:

- started the MSDAV program no later than spring 2023
- a graduation date of June 1, 2024 or later
