Digital User Experience Fellowship at Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts

Fellowship Application 2023-2024

Fellowship information

Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts (LCPA) is home to 11 resident arts organizations that present music, theater, dance, film, opera, and more, and is a cultural and civic cornerstone of New York City. The purpose of the Digital User Experience Fellowship at LCPA is to provide students with the opportunity to apply the skills and knowledge in the area of user experience (UX) testing and evaluation to a practical setting. Students who are interested in making improvements to LCPA digital interfaces are encouraged to apply.

This fellowship will be particularly concerned with usability testing and making improvements to existing web properties. The student will work with the staff that is remote, and must be comfortable with prototyping software (e.g., Sketch or Adobe XD).

The fellowship recipient will commit for 8 hours/week (120 hours/semester for the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters; 30 weeks total from September 2023-May 2024). This fellowship includes a scholarship in the amount of \$7,450 that will be divided equally between the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters. The successful applicant must take at least 6 credits in both the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters.

Please note that continuing the fellowship through spring 2024 is contingent upon review of the fall 2023 semester by LCPA staff. The fellowship recipient will be selected by LCPA staff following an initial review by SI staff. Official notification will be made by mid-July 2023.

Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration, an applicant must:

- Have started the MSIXD program no later than spring 2023 and have a graduation date no earlier than spring 2024
- Have completed INFO 643 Information Architecture and Interaction Design and INFO 644 Usability Theory & Practice.
- Have ability to use Sketch/Adobe XD

- Have a strong ability to collaborate with team members
- Be interested in supporting the performing arts and LCPA's mission
- Agree to take INFO 698 Practicum in Spring 2024 –OR– present work done at the fellowship at #infoshow24, the annual showcase of student work in May 2024.
