PROFILE

Adeena Karasick, Ph.D, is a New York based Canadian poet, performer, cultural theorist and media artist and the author of 12 books of poetry and poetics. Her Kabbalistically inflected, urban, Jewish feminist mashups have been described as “electricity in language” (Nicole Brossard), “proto-ecstatic jet-propulsive word torsion” (George Quasha), noted for their “cross-fertilization of punning and knowing, theatre and theory” (Charles Bernstein) “a twined virtuosity of mind and ear which leaves the reader deliciously lost in Karasick’s signature ‘syllabic labyrinth’” (Craig Dworkin). Most recently is *Massaging the Medium: 7 Pechakuchas*, (The Institute of General Semantics Press: 2022), shortlisted for Outstanding Book of the Year Award (ICA, 2023), *Salomé: Woman of Valor* (University of Padova Press, Italy, 2017), the libretto for her Spoken Word opera; *Salomé: Woman of Valor CD*, (NuJu Records, 2020), *Salomé Birangona*, translation into Bengali (Boibhashik Prokashoni Press, Kolkata, 2020), *Ærotomania: The Book of Lumenations*, and *Ouvert: Oeuvre: Openings*, (Lavender Ink Press, 2023). She teaches Literature and Critical Theory for the Humanities and Media Studies Dept. at Pratt Institute, and Poetry and Poetics for Brandeis University; Poetry Editor for *Explorations in Media Ecology*, 2019, Associate International Editor of *New Explorations: Studies in Culture and Communication*, Andrew W. Mellon Foundation Award recipient and winner of the 2016 Voce Donna Italia award for her contributions to feminist thinking.
