

Arthur O. Eve HEOP Freshman Applicant Eligibility Information

Higher Education Opportunity Program is for New York State Students who need academic and financial aid assistance. Eligibility for the program is subject to academic and economic criteria.

To be eligible for admission to Arthur O. Eve HEOP you must be:

- New York State resident for 12 months prior to enrollment
- Ineligible for admission under traditional standards, but demonstrate potential for completing a college program
- In need of financial assistance within established income guidelines
