INTERACTIVE FACULTY WORKSHOP: BAKING DEI INTO SCHOOL OF INFORMATION COURSES

The goal of this workshop is to make concrete revisions to course content to make DEI commitments in curriculum more apparent and honor Pratt's commitment to diversify the curriculum. Specifically, faculty teaching in likeminded areas will break into groups to discuss and "bake" DEI into courses, such as updating student learning outcomes, adding DEI expectations to assignments or projects, and adding DEI-relevant readings.

Also in this workshop, we will unveil the revised learning outcomes for the MSLIS core curriculum (INFO 601 Foundations of Information, INFO 652 Reference and Instruction, INFO 653 Knowledge Organization, INFO 654 Information Technologies) which were developed by the LIS Core Curriculum Task Force with feedback from faculty teaching those core courses. In the workshop, faculty teaching those core courses will have an opportunity to discuss in small groups ways to enact those DEI-related learning outcome revisions and update syllabi to reflect them. Our aim is to have revised syllabi that can be submitted to the School Curriculum Committee by the fall.
