MoMA Library Fellowship 2024-2025

Fellowship information

The fellowship presents the opportunity to participate in several aspects of MoMA library operations. The fellow will focus their time on reference, collection development, and acquisition activities. Particular projects will be determined at the start of the fellowship but may include such tasks as reading room staffing, assessing current reference tools, and backlog appraisal and remediation. Appropriate training and supervision will be provided for any tasks assigned. The ideal candidate will have demonstrated a knowledge of and interest in art history, particularly modern and contemporary art, and be excited to learn of the particular role the museum library plays within the institution.

The fellow will work onsite in the MoMA Library, Manhattan, though some work may be required at MoMA QNS in Long Island City for 8 hours/week (120 hours/semester for the fall 2024 and spring 2025 semesters).

This fellowship includes a scholarship in the amount of \$7,730 that will be divided equally between the fall 2024 and spring 2025 semesters. Fellows must register for the following courses:

INFO 667 Art Librarianship

INFO 698 Practicum/Seminar or present their fellowship project at #infoshow2025

If the fellowship recipient has previously taken INFO 667 Art Librarianship, the requirement can be substituted with a relevant course subject to the approval of the Dean of the School of Information. The successful applicant must take at least 6 credits in both the fall 2024 and spring 2025 semesters.

The fellow will be selected and supervised by Jillian Suarez, Head of Library Services. Official notification will be made by early May 2024.

Please note that continuing the fellowship through spring 2025 is contingent upon review of the fall 2024 semester by MoMA Library staff.

Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration, an applicant must have:

- started the MSLIS program no later than spring 2024
- a graduation date of June 1, 2025 or later
