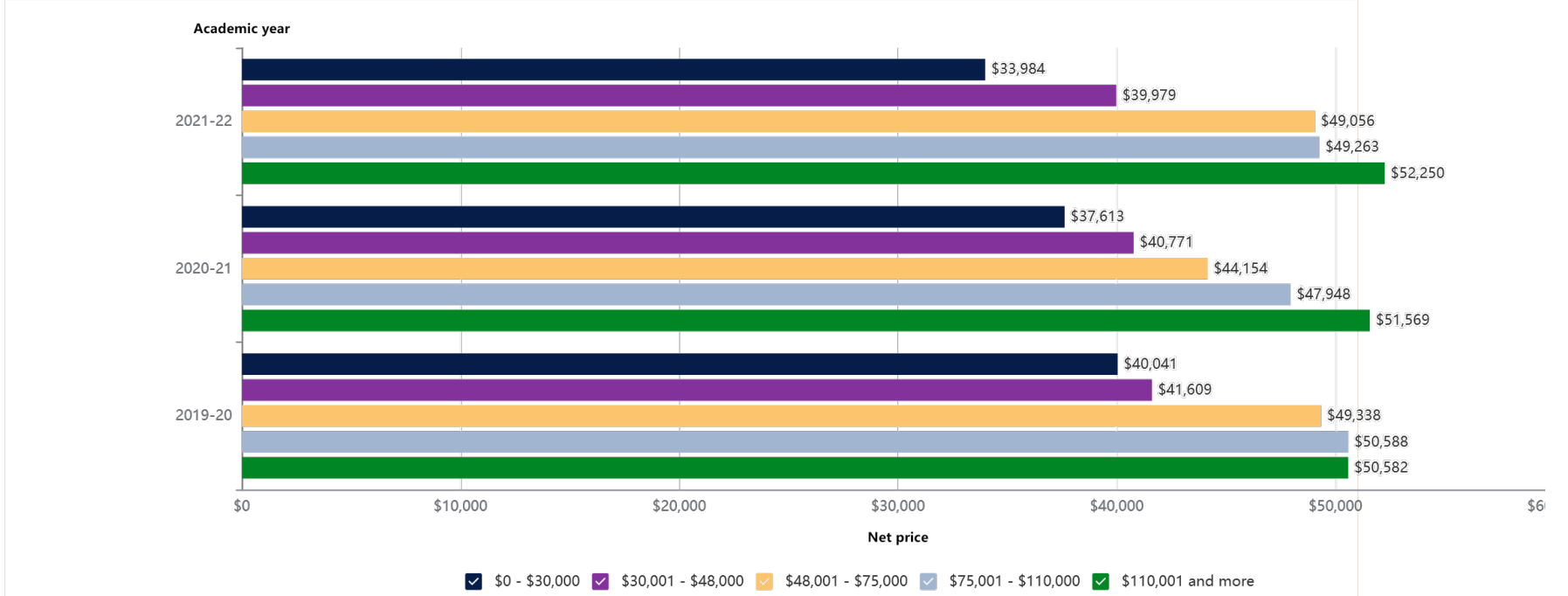

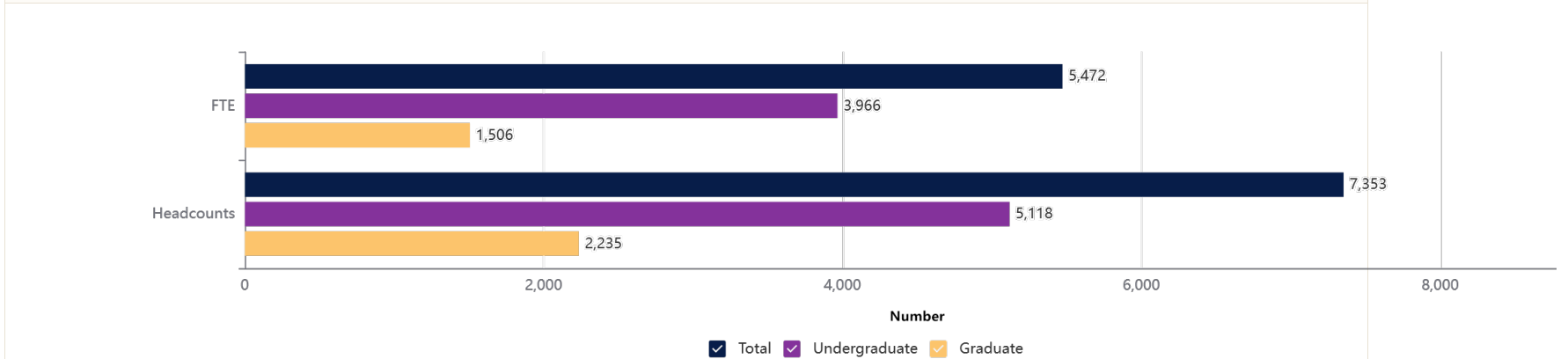

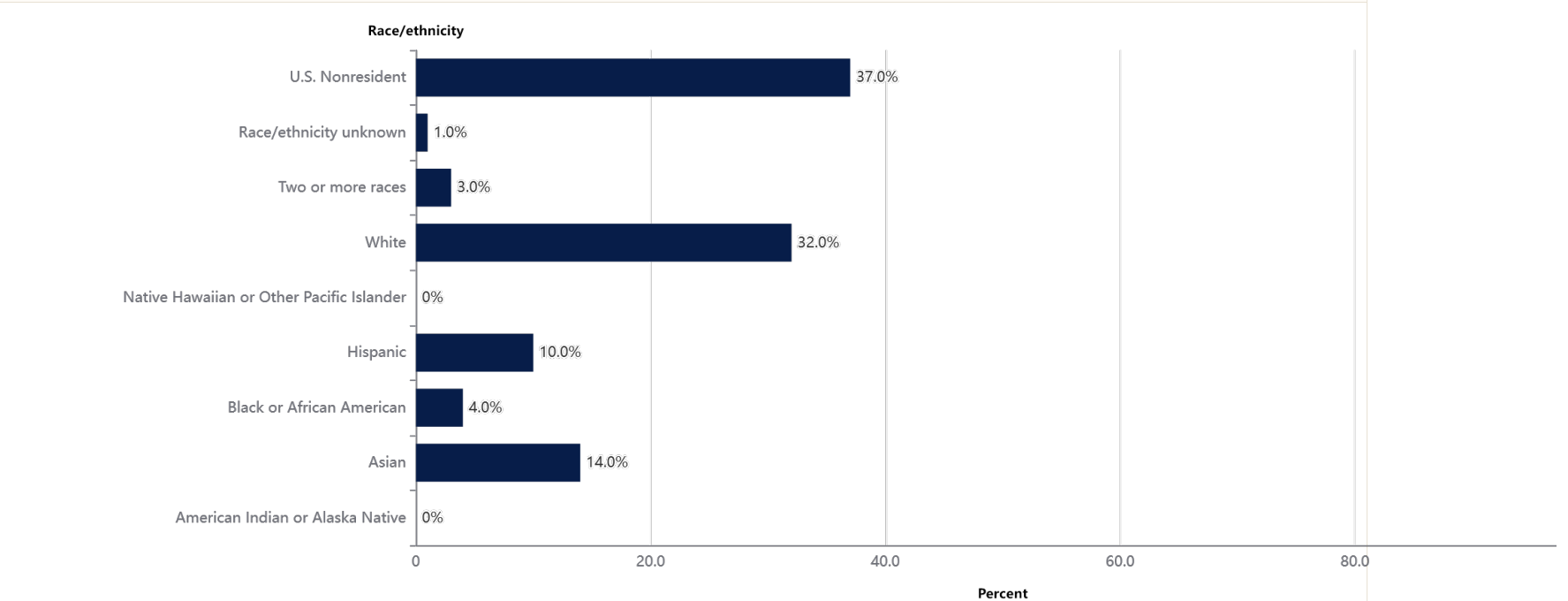

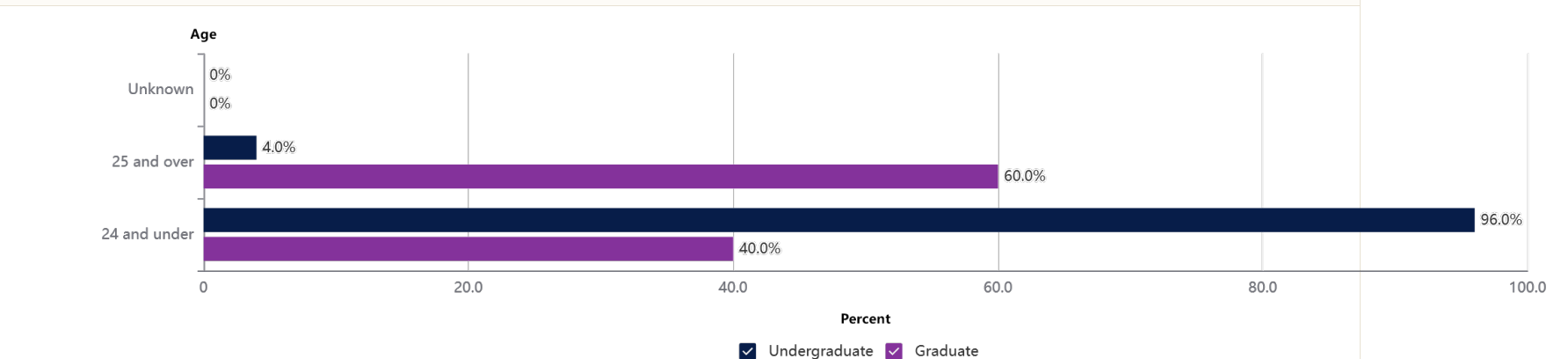
### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2022

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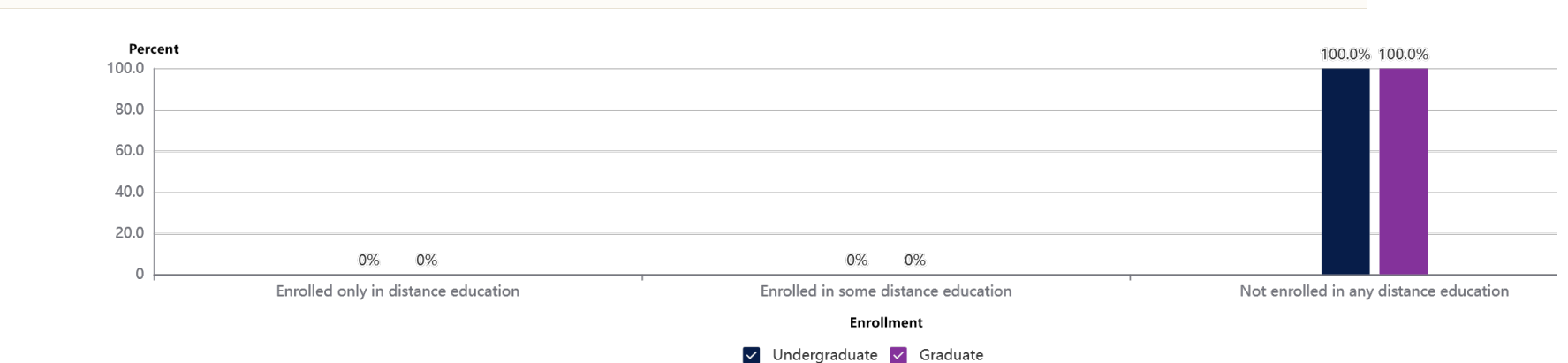
### Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2022

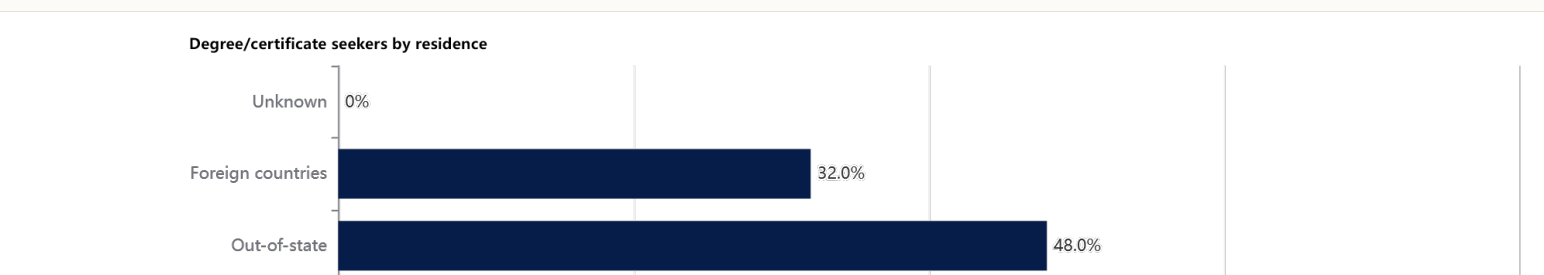

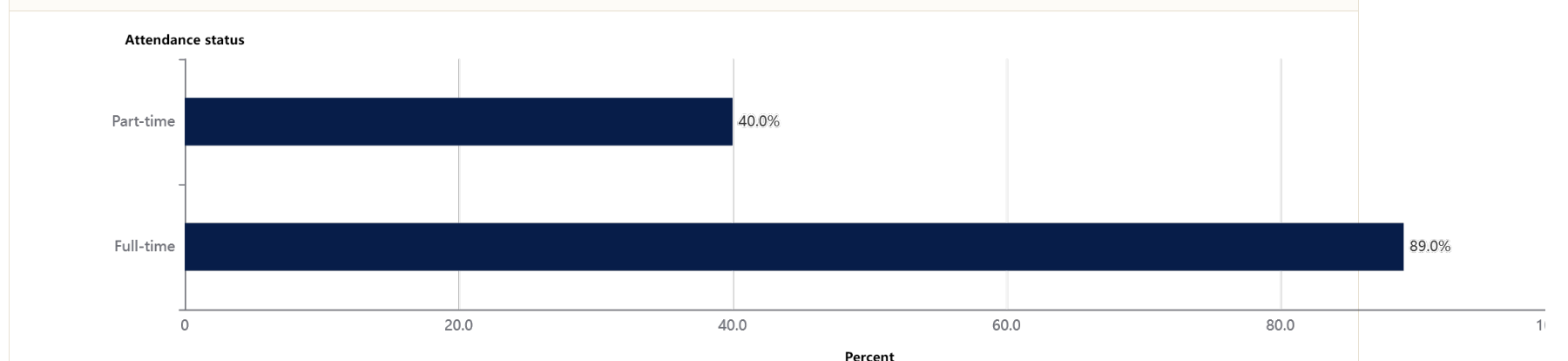
First to second year retention rates of first-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2022

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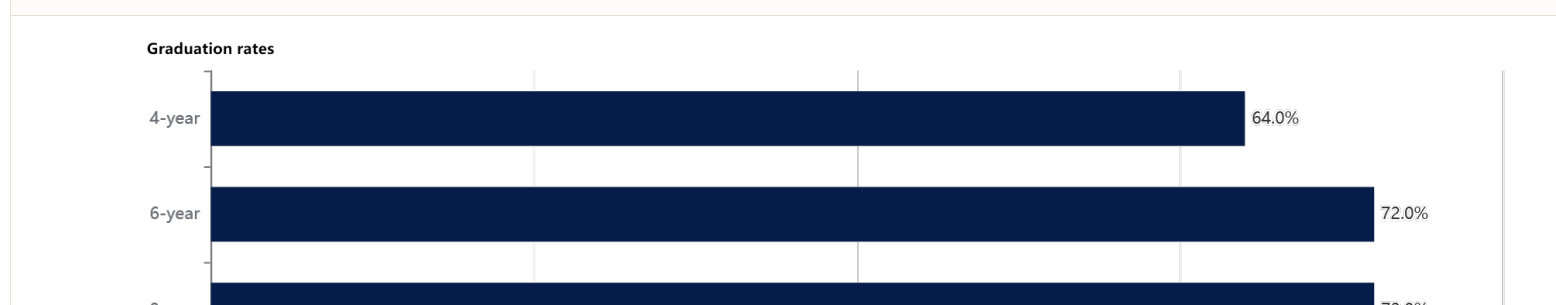
First to second year retention rates of first-time degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2022

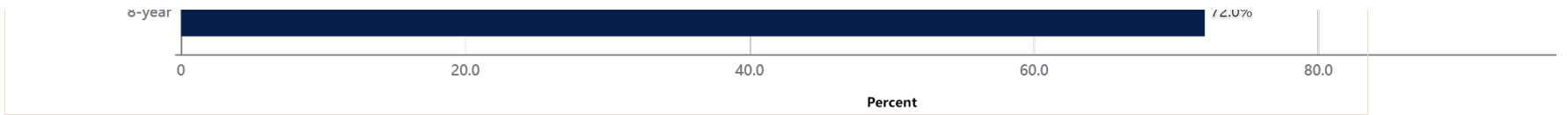

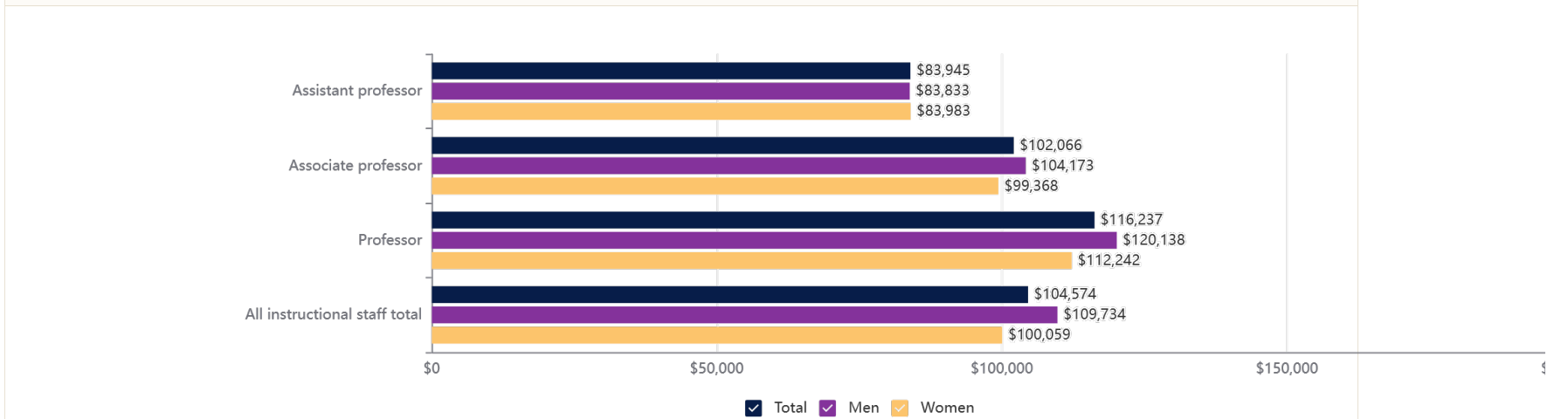

Average salaries of full-time instructional nonmedical staff equated to 9-months worked, by academic rank and gender: Academic year 2022-23

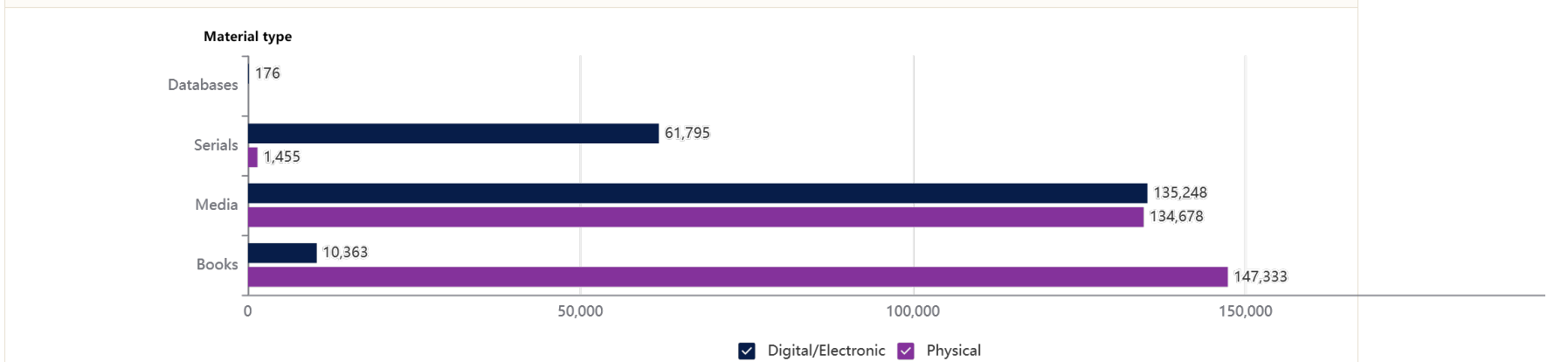

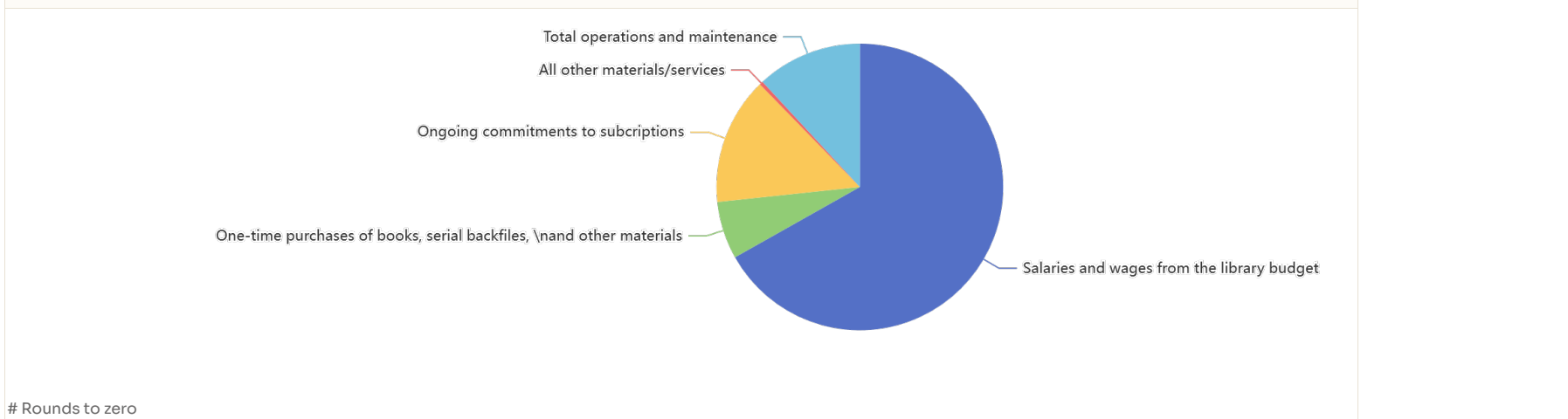
Library collection by material type: Fiscal year 2022
