- Submit your required additional information as soon as possible.

Reasons Your Financial Aid May Change

Aid eligibility is not fixed. The following situations may alter your financial aid. Contact your financial aid counselor with questions.

Additional Financial Aid

Notify us if you receive additional aid, such as private scholarships, Veteran benefits, fee waivers, employee educational benefits, vocational rehabilitation.

Verification

We are required to verify FAFSA data and may ask you to submit documents such as tax information. Changes to your FAFSA information could result in changes to your financial aid package.

Course Enrollment

Enrolling in fewer than 12 credit hours or in a self-paced course may reduce your aid. Pell Grant recipients must be able to document attendance.

Special Circumstances


Let your financial aid counselor know if you experience a sudden change in income or expenses. We may be able to reassess your family's aid eligibility due to loss of income, divorce, death in the family, layoff, etc.

Submit Enrollment Deposit to receive OneKey login instructions via email.

From onePratt there are a few ways to access Student Financial Aid and its direct functions.

1. On the home page, you can select the Self-Service icon from the tray of icons at the top, or select make it appear by clicking the plus sign and checking the box next to Self Service. From there you select Financial Aid.



- 2. This is the page where you can see the checklists and get forms needed to complete your financial aid. See the next page.
- 3. Make sure to select the correct award year since this is a drop down field. 2025-26 is the Financial Aid Award year beginning Fall 2025. Here you can see the checklist of items needed to complete. Under the resources tab on the right side of the page are the links to various resources you may need to complete your financial aid package.
- 4. When your package is complete, (you have followed the steps to accept your financial aid awards) it will indicate completed.
- 5. If for any reason you have applied for financial aid and you see no financial aid information, please contact your financial aid counselor.
- 6. To Complete Loan Acceptance:
- A) Click "Master Promissory Note" under Helpful Links and login using FSA ID
- B) Click "Entrance Counseling" under Helpful Links and login using FSA ID You can also go directly to https://studentaid.gov/ to complete these two items

- C) Complete Steps A & B above
- D) Complete Master Promissory Note for Graduate PLUS
- E) Accept Unsubsidized Loans under My Awards
- F) Submit Graduate PLUS Loan Application

FOR PARENT PLUS LOANS

- F) Students click and submit "Parent Plus Loan Application" highlighted in blue
- G)Students need to authorize a proxy access for parent. See instructions on how to authorize: https://one.pratt.edu/s/article/Self-Service-Proxy-for-Students
- H) Parents will receive their OnePratt login
- I) Parents can use their OnePratt login to log into Self-Service-Financial Aid and complete the above Step 6 A (then click on the link, "I'm a Parent of an Undergraduate Student".)
- J) Parent will receive an email to sign the plus form electronically with their OnePratt login
